



## **Pubs, Clubs, Taverns and Bars Webinar – SafeWork SA**

In late 2025, SafeWork SA launched a 12-month compliance campaign focusing on workplace safety in pubs, clubs, bars and taverns across South Australia.

**Members are advised that as part of this campaign, SafeWork SA will be sharing what has been learnt and other useful WHS information in a free interactive webinar on 18 February 2026 from 10am-11am.**

This webinar has been designed to help support safer hospitality venues and attendees will gain insights into:

- The most common safety issues uncovered
- What compliance looks like under WHS laws
- Simple ways to reduce risk in their venue.

**Members who are unsure about their safety obligations and want more information on some of the key requirements WHS legislation imposes are urged to attend.**

Members are also advised that whilst the *Work Health & Safety Act 2012 (SA)* only applies to those with paid employees, purely volunteer run clubs also have safety obligations under common law and the information gained in this webinar will also help guide best practice steps they can take.
